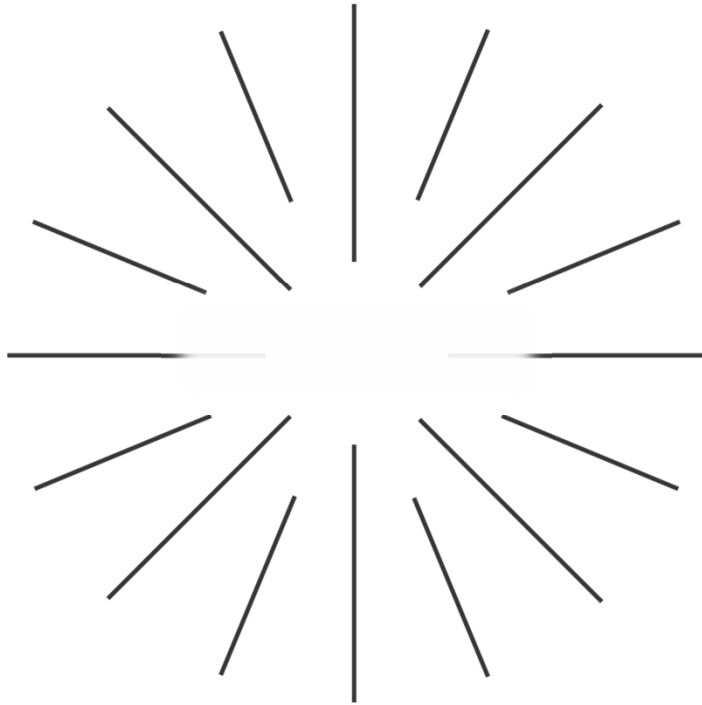

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# Admissions Process & Considerations



- Timeframe: Most students apply in January of 2<sup>nd</sup> year for entrance in fall of 3<sup>rd</sup> year
- The Undergraduate Admission Committee commits to creating a class through a holistic admissions process that...
  - Brings a **diversity of experience, background and skills**
  - Possesses **intellectual curiosity**
  - Is **academically prepared**
  - Is **highly engaged** with the UVA, Charlottesville, and global community
  - Demonstrates **emotional intelligence**

# Admissions: Prerequisites Courses



Course	Suggested Year
Foundations of Commerce: COMM 1800 L - Z = Fall    A - K = Spring	1 <sup>st</sup> year
First Writing Requirement: ENWR 1505/1506, 1507/1508, or 1510 A - K = Fall    L - Z = Spring	1 <sup>st</sup> year
<b>Calculus:</b> MATH 1190, 1210, 1310 (or higher)	1 <sup>st</sup> year
<b>Statistical Analysis:</b> STAT 2120	1 <sup>st</sup> year
Humanities (6 credits) / Engagements (8 credits)	1 <sup>st</sup> or 2 <sup>nd</sup> year
Foreign/World Language through 2020 level	1 <sup>st</sup> or 2 <sup>nd</sup> year
<b>Principles of Economics:</b> ECON 2010 and ECON 2020	1 <sup>st</sup> or 2 <sup>nd</sup> year
<b>Introductory Accounting:</b> COMM 2010 and COMM 2020 <i>online</i>	2 <sup>nd</sup> year

# Admissions: Advising Recommendations

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- Take **full course loads**.
- **Challenge yourself** with **rigorous courses** across **many** of disciplines/areas, honing your:
  - Oral and written communication
  - Ethics and moral reasoning
  - Global perspective
  - Quantitative skill set
  - Creative and critical thinking abilities
- Stay on track to **complete requirements** in the College of Arts and Sciences
- **Explore** the many majors and elective courses available at UVA
- **Create a balanced schedule:** avoid taking more than 2 quantitative prerequisite courses in the same semester
- **Get involved** outside of the classroom
